IMPORTANT NOTES

ADMISSION TICKETS	Each senior will receive 9 tickets to Commencement.
DRESS FOR GRADUATION	Dresses should be white or light in color (patterned materials and dark colors show through the white gown). Shoes should be appropriate for walking and for a formal ceremony. No tennis shoes, boots, flip flops, etc. Students must wear graduation caps at Baccalaureate and Commencement.
DISPLAY OF AWARDS	At Baccalaureate and Commencement, seniors may display only designations and distinctions that are given by Holy Names Academy. These are limited to Honor Cords, Valedictorian and Salutatorian medals, and the Scholar/Athlete Award. No non-HNA awards or honors may be worn with the gowns; this includes flowers. Students may display non-HNA distinctions at the Class Day assembly.
EXPECTATIONS	<p>ATTENDANCE – Seniors must attend all practices in preparation for Baccalaureate, Commencement, and Class Day and continue to observe school parking policies.</p> <p>BEHAVIOR – During practices and ceremonies, conduct should be appropriate for the formal ceremony. Suitable behavior is expected at all ceremonies as a sign of respect for fellow graduates, family and alumnae. All school rules still apply. In cases of questionable behavior during senior events and ceremonies, appropriate disciplinary action will be taken by the school administration.</p>
