Thank you for considering hosting a Summer Social for Incoming HNA 9th graders and their families in your area. These events are a great way for students to meet some of their new classmates before school starts. As you'll see, hosting is easy and many families are very eager to help. To get you started, the HNA Summer Social Co-Chairs will provide you with a list of families in your area, along with contact information. Here's what you will need to do.

1	Decide on a date. This is the hardest part! Mid-August (around the Book Sale and 9th-Grade Overnight) is a popular time, as most people are back in town by then. However, some regions have elected to do their events in June or July so that the young women can strengthen friendships they made at the Summer Social over the summer. It's entirely up to your group.
2	Choose a location. The most popular location is outdoors, typically at a public park. However, some groups choose to host the event in a home or at a local club they may belong to. Again, it's up to you.
3	E-mail your Summer Social Co-Chair contact with your event date and location as soon as you know it. We are keeping a master list in the Admissions Office.
4	Decide what kind of potluck you want to have. Some groups do dinner; some just do dessert, and everything in between. Signupgenius.com is a great way to keep track of who is bringing what.
5	Send out a save-the-date e-mail to all families as soon as you know your date. We would prefer that these go out by the end of May.
6	Three weeks prior to the event, send out an Evite or e-mail invite. If you used signupgenius.com, be sure to include the link to the event you created in their tool.
7	One week prior to the event, send out a reminder.
8	Have fun!
