Dear Seniors and Senior Parent/Guardians,

The HNA Senior Prom will be held Friday, May 26, from 8:00 p.m. until midnight at the Space Needle (100 Level). The date is fast approaching and the excitement is building! We want everyone to have a wonderful evening—one that is also safe and a reflection of every student's best behavior. Therefore, we have developed the following guidelines for this event to promote tradition, safety, and community spirit.

1. Students will sign up for prom picture appointments, which will be taken at Holy Names Academy. Weather permitting, pictures will be taken on the front lawn; otherwise, they will be taken in the school parlors. After students have taken their prom pictures, they will greet their teachers and introduce their prom guests. Faculty and staff will line up for the reception of the students and their guests in St. Joseph's Alcove on the second floor. Only students and prom guests are allowed inside the building.
2. Students will arrive at the Space Needle between 7:30 and 8:00 p.m. If a student is delayed, please contact the Space Needle at (206) 443-9800 and ask for Mr. Karp or Ms. Kelly on the 100 Level.
3. As at all HNA-sponsored activities, the Prom is an alcohol- and drug-free event. As stated in the *HNA Handbook*, students will be chosen randomly to complete a breathalyzer test.
4. As at all HNA-sponsored activities, smoking is not allowed.
5. As is customary at our dances, once students have left the event, they may not re-enter. Students may not leave the event before 11:00 p.m. for any reason. The Observation Deck will open after 9:30 p.m.; the time will be announced and the area will be supervised.
6. HNA encourages students to carefully consider all choices related to after-prom activities and communicate all plans with parents. HNA does not promote or sponsor any after-prom activities and reminds all students to make responsible choices, be aware of personal safety, and to look out for one other.
7. Please be aware that any behavior reflecting negatively on the reputation of Holy Names Academy will have disciplinary consequences.
8. Etiquette reminder: Please remember to tip the valet parking attendant if you use this service. ☺
