


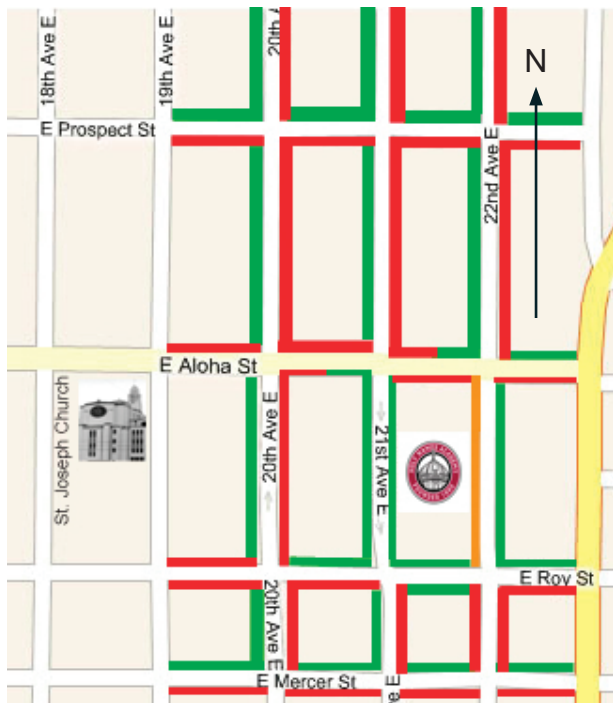


HNA NEIGHBORHOOD PARKING RULES

-  No parking for Holy Names Academy
-  If a legal parking spot, OK to park for HNA
-  After-school 15-minute wait zone only

SAMPLE ONLY. HNA side-of-street restrictions apply to ALL streets in the neighborhood (see back of this card).



HOLY NAMES ACADEMY PARKING GUIDELINES

HNA's two **parking lots** (off 22nd Ave.) are restricted to faculty, staff, parents, and visitors.

SPECIAL HNA STREET PARKING RULES:

Parking for all HNA school days and events—at any hour, whether by students, parents, or faculty/staff—is restricted to:

- Any legal parking spot on E. Aloha Street.
- The NORTH side only of other streets running east/west (Roy, Prospect, Mercer, etc.), but only in a legal space. You may park on either side of the blocks immediately adjacent to the HNA campus, as noted below.
- The WEST SIDE ONLY of streets running north/south (20th, 21st, 22nd, etc.). You may park on either side of the blocks immediately adjacent to the HNA building, as noted below.
- Both sides of the streets around the immediate four sides of the HNA campus—but only in a legal space. The entire west side of 22nd Avenue between Aloha and Roy is always a no-parking zone, but can be used for waiting during the 15-minute after-school pickup.

Observe city parking regulations and common courtesy to our neighbors. In particular, **DO NOT:**

- Park within 5 feet of a driveway, alley, or lowered curb area.
- Park within 3 feet of another vehicle.
- Park in a space marked for the disabled unless the driver has a placard or license plate for the disabled.
- Text or talk on a phone while driving.
